WALK-IN INTERVIEW

Divisional Forest Officer, Rourkela Forest Division, invites Application from Interested Candidate for engagement of One Veterinary Officer, One Livestock Assistant & Two Attendants for Mobile Veterinary Unit (MVU) of Rourkela Forest Division. The Walk-in-interview is scheduled on **07.07.2023** at 11:00 AM in the conference hall of Rourkela Forest Division. The application form along with detail terms and conditions shall be available on the website www.sundargarh.nic.in/ www.odishaforest.in from dt.19.06.2023 to 06.07.2023.

Candidates interested in contractual engagement in Rourkela Forest Division may avail the opportunity through walk-in interview to be conducted at Divisional Forest Office, Rourkela. This post is purely contractual and the engagement can be terminated at any time in case of unsatisfactory Performance/non-availability of funds or any other reasons, Initial engagement will be for 6 months.

Aim:

Mobile Veterinary Unit for Wildlife will help immensely providing in situ healthcare services to sick & injured wild animals requiring immediate attention & treatment. It will also be helpful in many ways by providing healthcare services during disease outbreaks, natural calamities & public emergency.

Objectives:

1. To provide urgent & need based healthcare services to sick & injured wild animals.
2. To make daily surveillance and monitoring of wild animals.
3. To attend unprecedented disease outbreaks in wild animals.
4. To provide diagnostic services on the spot to screen out the diseases.
5. To reduce man-animal conflicts through creation of awareness among the local people about peaceful coexistence.
6. To help anti depredation squad for rescue & rehabilitation of wild animals upon entering into human habitation at times of need.

7. To create awareness among livestock owners in the forest fringe areas about bio-security.
8. To perform different Departmental activities as per the need of the situation.
9. To assist the departmental staff in constituting Range level rescue team and build their capacity on aspects of wild life rescue, rehabilitation and translocation through regular training programme in consultation with the DFO.

Veterinary services to be provided:

1. Treatment of different cases of wild animals at the site of detection.
2. Referral of complicated cases to the concerned Chief District Veterinary Officer/ College of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry, OUAT, Bhubaneswar.
3. Early detection of communicable & non-communicable diseases.
4. Tranquilization/sedation of wild animals.
5. Curative treatment to sick/injured wild animals.
6. Reviewing/monitoring preventive vaccination of livestock & poultry in forest areas.
7. Creation of public health awareness.
8. On spot examination of Fecal Sample (F/S), Blood Sample (B/S), Urine Sample (U/S), Skin Scrapping (S/S).
9. Collection of both ante mortem & post mortem samples & their subsequent delivery to referral laboratory for further diagnosis.
10. Provision of healthcare services at times of diseases outbreaks/ natural calamities.
11. Sensitization of farmers about bio security measures by conducting village meetings and using suitable Information, Education & Communication (IEC) materials like leaflets/pamphlets.

Area of Operation:

In view of unusual morbidity and mortality of wild elephants, increase in cases of man-animal conflict, protection and conservation of wild elephants in reserve areas as well as vulnerability of the wild animals to various anthropogenic factors, there is an urgent need for induction of Mobile Veterinary Units (MVUs) at prioritized places in order to provide wildlife health care and disease control services on priority basis. The MVU will render the disease surveillance and other related disease control activities in Rourkela Circle area.

In case of emergency requirement of MVU in other adjacent/nearby Forest Division, the services of available MVU may be tapped for judicious and efficacious use of existing department resources.

Although the MVU will be managed by the DFO of the concerned division but its emergency deployment in neighboring division within the circle will be made solely by the concerned RCCF.

Coverage:

One MVU will be covering One Forest Division covering all the identified interior villages in Forest Fringe areas **once in a month**.

Operational Modalities:

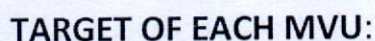


1. The MVU shall be operationalized and managed by the concerned DFO.
2. The staff of MVU shall be outsourced through open advertisement followed by transparent selection procedure at each Division.
3. The DFO will sign an agreement with the outsourcing agencies for engagement of staff of MVU.
4. The Range Officers will identify the villages/areas within Forest for the visit of MVU team.
5. The MVU will operate as per the route chart approved by the DFO.
6. Fixed date, fixed site & fixed time will be followed by the MVU.
7. Proper funding of the MVU vehicles shall be made.
8. The performance of the MVU shall be reviewed by the Assistant Conservator of Forests once in a month.

PROPOSED MONTHLY WORK PLAN:

Activities	Days	Remarks
Provision of preventive and curative healthcare services as per the approved monthly tour programme.	20 days	The monthly programme scheduled will be prepared as per the local need. The Departmental activities will be carried out along with the programme.
Attending surveillance work	5 days	Conducting physical Surveillance on diseases of wildlife as per the requirement.

5 days in a month will be treated as weekly off days for the MVU staff. But in case of emergency, they have to perform their duties as per the **requirement**. The vehicle should be engaged through-out the month.



Roles & Responsibilities of MVU Staff:

As a team manager s/he shall bear overall responsibility for the effective functioning of the MVU. The other support staff of the MVU would work under his guidance and supervision.

- Name of the livestock owner contacted.



- Particulars of examination conducted/observation made.
 - Cross checking of vaccination status of domestic animals in forest areas.
 - Awareness programme conducted.
 - Sample collected and dispatched to any referral laboratory.
 - Logbook of the vehicle.
 - Any particular matter worth reporting.
6. Any other work to be assign as per the requirement from time to time.

B) Livestock Assistant:

1. S/he will be assist the Veterinary Doctor, in-charge of MVU in all above said healthcare & diseases control services in animals.
2. S/he should have a good coordination with local Livestock Inspector/other workers of Animal Husbandry Department.
3. S/he will take care of all the medicine & instrument stocks.
4. S/he shall maintain all registers & records.

C) Livestock Attendant:

1. S/he will assist the Veterinary Officer during supportive & curative treatment of injured sick wild animals.
2. S/he will help him transportation of required equipment from the vehicle to the site of treatment.
3. S/he will work under the direct control of Veterinary Officer of MVU as per the instruction & requirement of the situation from time to time.

Monitoring and Supervision:

1. Regular concurrent monitoring and supervision of the MVUs will be done by DFO of concerned units with assistance and active role of ACF concerned.
2. Similarly, when the vehicle is under deputation to other divisions within the circle, the concerned DFO and ACF are going to monitor its activities.
3. Work done certificate has to be submitted at the end of every month by the Veterinarian of the MVU, which has to be verified



and passed by the DFO before processing of remuneration and associated bills for hire charges, POL, procurements made etc.

4. Quarterly performance review will be done by the RCCFs of the Circle.

Project Period:

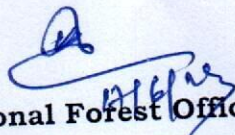
The engagement of these units will be for a period of **five years**. Basing on the efficacy of these units further extension will be considered.
